



Asian Community Games 2016 Tenpin Bowling Tournament

Rules and Regulations

1. This tournament is organized by Asian Community Games in partnership with Zone Bowling Club

2. Eligibility

Open to all ages of Canadian citizens and Canadian residents.

3. Venue – World Bowl

Registration - 8:30 am to 9:00 am

Opening ceremony & photo sessions – 9:00 am to 9:30 am

Regular 8-game Series -

Squad 1 (4 games) , 9:30 am – 12:30 pm

Squad 2 (4 games) , 1:30 pm – 4:30 pm

* Lanes will be re-dressed after squad 1

* Different oil patterns will be used for each squad. Details will be announced in ACG & Zone Bowling Club's website.

Master Championship Round –

4:45 pm to 5:45 pm - Singles only, 1-game elimination

5. Entry fee: \$50 + HST 13% per person

6. Format of tournament - Scratch only

Regular Series -

All bowlers are required to bowl 8 games in the regular series.

The scratch scores from all 8 games are counted for determining the champion, 1st and 2nd runners up in each of the following events.

4-person Team (Men, Women or Mixed)
(maximum league average – 780 per team)

Doubles Team (Men, Women or Mixed)
(maximum league average – 390 per double)

*** If any team member does not have eligible league average, the average of 200 is automatically assigned to the member.

Singles event is divided into 3 divisions – Div. A (league average 191 or above), Div. B (league average 176 to 190)
Div. C (league average 175 or below). If there is no eligible league average, the bowler will be classified under Div. A.

Master Championship Round -

All individuals 8-game scores will be lined up in separate Men's and Women's divisions. Top 4 scores in each division will be seeded in Men's Adult and Women's Adult divisions. The next 4 highest scores from the remaining individuals with age 50+ in each division will be seeded in the Men's Senior and Women's Senior divisions. (Proof of age is required for the senior individuals) .

The top 4 individuals in their seeded division will compete in a one-game elimination semi-final round. 1st vs 4th position, 2nd vs 3rd position. Winners of the semi-final match in each division will bowl one game to determine the Master Champion in each division.

7. Bowler's eligible league average (for determining the event & group of each bowler only)

Bowler's league average is based on the 2014-2015 CTF year book and 2015-2016 current Canadian league average of minimum 21 games, by April 30, 2016, whichever highest will be applied.

8. Registration & deadline

*** *Deadline is on May 21, 2016. Registration will be closed before the deadline if the available spots are full.*

All registrations are to be submitted to the Asian Community Games office in care of Sing Fai Sports Club. Zone Bowling Club will assist to collect the registrations.

Participants can form their own 4-person team, and doubles team when register. The ACG tournament committee can assist to form the 4-person team and doubles team for participants registered as individuals.

9. Medal Awards*

Gold, Silver & Bronze medals are awarded to the Champion, 1st runner-up & 2nd runner-up in each event (4-person team, doubles team, single – group A , group B, and group C) in the regular series.

Master Championship Trophy & gold medal are awarded to the master champion in the men adult, men senior, women adult & women senior division in the master championship round. Silver medal is awarded to the second position. Bronze medal is awarded to the 3rd & 4th position.

Special awards (Bowling balls sponsored by Brunswick)

1 bowling ball for the highest single game of the regular series only in each of the following group (male or female) :-

- Eligible league average 191 or above
- Eligible league average 176 to 190
- Eligible league average 175 or below

Special awards (Bowling coupons sponsored by World Bowl)

1 coupon for each of the highest score in squad 1 – game 2, 3, 4 only

1 coupon for each of the highest score in squad 2 – game 6, 7, 8 only

*** *bowlers will only be awarded once in the order of the game sequence*

11. Tie breakers

Regular Series

When there is a tie for the position of Champion or 1st runner-up or 2nd runner-up, the high games score of the Team, Doubles & high game score of the Singles will determine the winning positions.

Master Championship Round

2 frames roll-off , 9th and 10th frame, to determine the winner.

15. Etiquettes

One lane courtesy is observed. Non-CTF approved powder is not allowed in bowler's area and approach. Non-bowler is not allowed in bowler's area. **Headphones may only be used in between frames during competition. It must be taken off when shooting the ball.**

16. Unacceptable Bowler's attire per following (Dress Code)

Tank tops halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, short shorts, jeans that are torn, not clean or in poor condition, no torn tee shirts. Failure to comply will result in disqualify and rejection by the tournament committee to bowl in the tournament.

17. Bowling balls

- It is the bowler's responsibility to ensure that all bowling balls used during the tournament are verified legal under CTF/USBC specifications. Tournament committee reserve the right to examine the balls used by the participants. Use of an illegal ball will lead to disqualification and forfeiture of games, awards and standings aside from any other penalties that may be imposed.
- Altering the surface of the bowling ball during a game is not allowed (i.e. only after completion / before commencement of each game), provided they are made at designated area and must not delay the bowler's and other's next turn / short.

18. ACG adjudication

- This is a non-sanctioned tournament. However, all tournament rules published by CTF /USBC will be applied.
- ACG reserves the right to accept or refuse entry to this tournament.
- Any disputes will be settled by the ACG tournament committee
- Any appeal must be submitted in writing to ACG within 7 days after the tournament for ACG committee's review.
