

CBC 2013-14 Winter Leagues – League Rules Highlights

Individual Match Points (per game)

- 1 point is awarded to the winner of each match game.
- In the case of a "tie", points are split.

Team Game Points (per game)

- 1 point is awarded to the winner of each team game.
- In the case of a "tie", points are split.

Team Series Points (per series)

- 2 points are awarded for the winner of the team series (total pinfall with handicap).
- In the case of a "tie", points are split.

Bonus Points (per game)

- 1 pin over "Team Average" receives 1 point.
- 31 pins over "Team Average" receive 2 points.
- 61 pins over "Team Average" receive 3 points.
- "Team Average" is the sum of the averages of the bowlers who bowled.

Absent Score

- An ABSENTEE score shall be the bowler's average less 15 pins.
- Teams shall use the absentee score of the absent player on the roster with the lowest average.
- When bowling against an ABSENTEE:
 - The player must beat the absentee score.
 - In case of a tie, the points are split (divided equally).
- When ABSENTEE bowls against ABSENTEE:
 - Point is split equally.
- When ABSENTEE bowls against DUMMY:
 - Receives 0 point.
- The bowlers must order themselves on the roster from low to high average.

Dummy Team

- When bowling against a dummy team:
 - The player must bowl equal or more than his average to win the points. In the case of a "tie", the player wins the points (points are not split).
 - The team must bowl equal or more than the team average to win the points. The team average is the sum of the averages of the bowlers who bowled. In the case of a "tie", the team wins the points (points are not split).

No Bowling Week

- No bowling from December 24th 2013 to January 1st 2014

Individual Handicaps

- Men
 - The handicap shall be 80% (except Tuesday Cash League: 85%) of the difference between the bowler's average and 220 (except Tuesday Cash League: 230).
 - The handicap shall be limited to 60 pins per game (except Tuesday Cash League: 80).
 - For bowlers without a book average (last 2 years), a fixed average of 170 shall be used for the first 3 games bowled.
- Women
 - The handicap shall be 80% (except Tuesday Cash League: 85%) of the difference between the bowler's average and 220 (except Tuesday Cash League: 230).
 - The handicap shall not be limited (except Tuesday Cash League: Max 90).
 - For bowlers without a book average (last 2 years), a fixed average of 160 shall be used for the first 3 games bowled.
- A bowler's average may not go more than 10 pins below his book average.

Position Rounds

- All bowlers require a verified average (CBC league average of 21 games, current or past 2 years) to compete in any position round of Championship or play-off series, unless otherwise announced by the league manager prior to the start of the league
- Bowlers without verified average shall receive '0' handicap.

Individual Award

- At the end of the season, a bowler must have completed 60 of the games to be eligible for a league award.

High Game of the Month

- \$100 cash award
- Only weekly high game bowler from each league is eligible.
- Bowlers are required to bowl at least 21 games in the season to qualify this award.
- The 'High Game of the month' is awarded for each month. Winner shall be determined by the highest single game with handicap within the month. In case of tied score, cash award shall be equally split. This award shall be presented at the award presentation banquet or the end of the season.

Change Line-up:

- Bowler line-up cannot be changed after March 28th 2014 (Friday).
- There shall be no transfer after March 28th 2014 (Friday).

Roll-off

- The maximum number of roll-off week per bowler per individual league shall not exceed
- 8 weeks for winter leagues.
- Only one set of roll-off score shall be allowed during the designated roll-off period (maximum of 4 weeks from the date of roll-off).
- The bowler must pay the normal weekly prize fund of \$9 for each day that the "roll-off" score shall apply.

Pacer:

- Pacer shall pay lineage fee of \$12 per week per bowler (apply to all leagues) to the Treasurer before the game starts.
