Rules and Regulations

- 1. This tournament is organized by Chinese Bowling Congress and is sponsored by Ming Pao Daily News
- 2. Eligibility

All current Chinese Bowling Congress leagues bowlers

- 3. Venue World Bowl, 9 East Wilmot Street, Richmond Hill
- 4. Date and Registration Time February 28, 2015, Saturday, 10:30 am to 11:00 am

5. Classification

One Division - No average limit

6. Entry fee: \$85

7. Averages

Highest average (minimum 21 games) of 2012 – 2013 Winter, 2013 – 2014 Winter from year book. Current 2014 – 2015 winter will be used (minimum 21 games) if no previous year book's average. With no valid average, a bowler shall use 230 as average.

8. Handicap

65% of (230 minus average), men max. 45, ladies max. 55 **9. Qualifying rounds**

• \$10 per one qualify entry, unlimited entries.

Dec 21, - 2014; Jan 11, 18, 25; Feb 1,8,15,22, - 2015 Special squad - Feb 22 (1p.m. to 3 p.m.)

- Total pin falls plus handicap of qualifying rounds will NOT carried forward to the semi-final round.
- Top 40 qualify scores will advance to semi-final round.

10. Semi-final round

Stage 1:

- All 40 bowlers will bowl 5 games.
- Top 20 scores with handicap will advance to stage 2 Stage 2:
- All 20 bowlers will be divided into 4 groups A,B,C and D, and will bowl two games. No scores from stage 1 will be carried forward. Position 1, 8, 12, 16 and 20 from stage 1 will be in group A. Position 2, 7, 11, 15 and 19 will be in group B. Position 3, 6, 10,14 and 18 will be in group C. Position 4, 5, 9, 13 and 17 will be in group D.

Top 2 bowlers scores with handicap from each group and 2 bowlers with wild cards will advance to stage 3. The wild card is given to the top 2 scores with handicap of the remaining bowlers from all groups in stage 2 only.

Stage 3: The 10 bowlers from stage 2 will be divided into 2 groups based on their stage 2 scores from highest to lowest. Position 1, 4, 6, 8 and wild card 2 will be in group A, and position 2, 3, 5, 7 and wild card 1 will be in group B. All 10 bowlers will bowl 2 games and *the top 2 scores with handicap from each group will advance to final round.*

11. Final round

The 4 bowlers from stage 3 of semi-final round will bowl 1 game, the top 2 scores with handicap will bowl one more game to determine the Champion.

12. Blind Double round

The remaining 20 bowlers from stage 1 and 10 bowlers from stage 2 of semi-final round will advance to a FREE randomly drawn home team blind double 2-game round. Top 3 double scores with handicap will cash from this round. Additional double entry can be purchased at \$10 per bowler.

13. Prizes^{*}

Champion - \$1000 + trophy
1 st runner-up - \$500
2 nd runner-up - \$250
3 rd runner-up - \$250
The highest score with handican from stage 3 which cannot make the

* All registered bowlers enter to the semi-final round will receive a "red pocket" for the Chinese New Year.

14. Tie breakers

top 4 - \$ 80

Qualifying rounds – the score with the earlier qualifying date will advance, If both scores were on same date, high game scratch of the set will advance. For Semi-final and final rounds – 2 frames roll-off, 9th and 10th frame With 1/5 of handicap rounded down added to the pinfalls.

15. Etiquettes

one lane courtesy is observed. Non-CTF approved powder is not allowed in bowler's area and approach. Non-bowler is not allowed in bowler's area

16.Bowler's attire

- No headgear or sleeveless shirt, no jeans with holes. For men, no shorts.
- Ladies may wear skirts, shorts or slacks.

17. Bowling balls

- It is the bowler's responsibility to ensure that all bowling balls used during the tournament are verified legal under CTF/USBC specifications. Tournament committee reserve the right to examine the balls used by the participants. Use of an illegal ball will lead to disqualification and forfeiture of games, prizes and standings aside from any other penalties that may be imposed.
- Altering the surface of the bowling ball during a game is not allowed (i.e. only after completion/before commencement of each game), provided they are made at designated area and must not delay the bowler's and other's next turn.

18. CBC adjudication

- This is a non-sanctioned tournament. However, all CTF /USBC tournament rules will apply.
- CBC reserves the right to accept or refuse entry to this tournament.
- Any disputes will be settled by the CBC tournament committee
- An appeal must be submitted in writing to CBC within 30 days after the tournament for CBC's final decision
